Some of us are in the Hospital Auxiliary so off we ran in our full regalia to help serve cakes and sandwiches to the public.

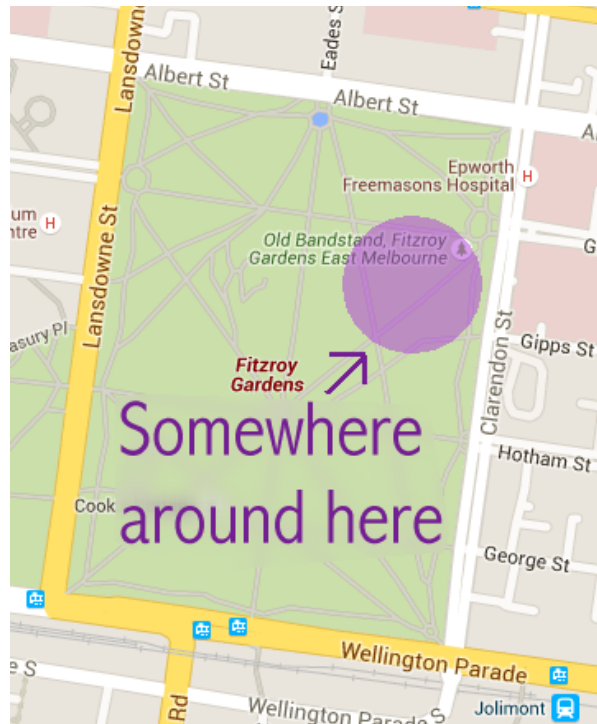
